

QUALIFICATIONS OF SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS

At the time of appointment or election to office, each member of the School Board must be a qualified voter and bona fide resident of the school division and district, which the member represents and meet any other criteria set forth in state law. If a Board member shall cease to be a resident of the school division or that district which the Board member represents, the member's position on the School Board shall be deemed vacant.

No employee of the School Board may serve on the Board.
