

SPECIAL SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

The School Board holds special and continued meetings when necessary. Special meetings are held when called by the chairperson or when requested by two or more members. Special meetings may be called provided each member is duly notified, or a reasonable attempt has been made to notify each member.

The School Board shall follow parliamentary procedure as outlined in Robert's Rule of Order.

Business that does not come within the purposes set forth in the call of the meeting is not transacted at any special meeting of the School Board unless the quorum present is in unanimous agreement to consider additional items of business.

Notice, reasonable under the circumstances, of special or continued meetings is given contemporaneously with the notice provided to members of the School Board.
