

PROMOTION

Students typically progress in a sequence from grade to grade and course to course within a given discipline. However, learning is a continuous process that does not end specifically with the school calendar year.

Students may not be retained in grades K-5 unless the teacher and/or parent appeals with academic evidence supporting the need not to promote. Social retention may not be considered as a legitimate appeal.

Grade-level placement of a student transferring into the Gloucester County Public School Division will be reviewed by the school principal when the student has repeated a grade level prior to the time of transfer.

Principals at the respective schools, in consultation with division staff, will facilitate consideration of a written request for not promoting a student. If approved, the principal will facilitate the development of an appropriate plan for remediation specific to the student's academic need.
