

**SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS**

The School Board establishes school attendance areas for each school. Students attend the school in the attendance area in which they reside and to which they are assigned, unless the School Board grants special permission. It is the policy of the Gloucester County School Board to adhere whenever practicable to the philosophy of maintaining a neighborhood school concept.

Changes in attendance areas are determined by the School Board, upon recommendation of the superintendent based on the need to provide for the orderly administration of the schools, the competent instruction of the students, and the health, safety, best interests and general welfare of all students.
