SCHOOL ATTENDANCE ZONES

Beginning with the 1999-2000 school year, the Division Superintendent will establish an elementary committee and a secondary committee to review school attendance zones on a triennial basis. Citizens from varied geographic areas of the county, parental representatives, building administrators, and district administrators shall make up the composition of the two committees.

Decisions about the redistricting of attendance zones will be made by the School Board using the following guidelines:

- 1. Balance the enrollment among the schools;
- 2. Meet the needs of exceptional students;
- 3. Consider travel time students spend on the school bus;
- 4. Use primary roads and natural landmarks as zone dividing lines;
- 4. Avoid dividing subdivisions between school zones;
- 5. Maintain communities within a zone; and,
- 6. Maintain the neighborhood school concept.
