

SALES AND SOLICITATIONS IN SCHOOLS

No one may sell or offer for sale, within the school, on school grounds, or at school-sponsored activities, any product or service except when the sale will benefit the educational program of the schools.

This does not prevent solicitation for the United Way, dues for employee organizations, contributions for the benefit of professional organizations, or for school organizations at regularly scheduled extracurricular events outside school hours. Exception: It may be permissible, with the principal's authorization, for schools to sell certain specialized merchandise pertaining to the individual school during school hours.

Individual discussions between school division employees during school hours are not prohibited.

The School Board prohibits students from accepting money for sports, contests, or activities that would nullify a student's eligibility to compete in school sponsored activities prior to graduation.
